TOPIC: THE POWER OF GOD

“God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power belongeth unto God.” (Psalm 62: 11)

The power of God is just the same today. I know that Heaven is rejoicing over you. I thank God He has made it possible for everyone of us to be in this camp meeting.

The spirit of God is whispering to me that, everybody is blessed. Power belongs to God. You will be leaving this camp meeting with a special weapon and that weapon is prayer.

There is power in prayer. May God help you to acquire this weapon. The power of God is greater than any other power. All power belongs to God. Everybody loves to have or will love to acquire power, but I pray that you will encounter power of the Most High.

“As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.” (Genesis 17:4, 5), this is an encounter Abraham had with the Almighty God.

WHAT IS PRAYER?

Prayer is a humble approach by man to God. I pray that God will give you power to pray. If you pray, you will see a wonderful change in your life. **“And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.” (Genesis 17:1).**

TOPIC: HOLINESS IN COMMUNICATION

“O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. But I say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the Day of Judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.” (Matthew 12:34-37)

We thank God for making us a part of this company on the way to heaven. May God help us get there. We have heard that without holiness, we cannot see God. This requirement is not only in our choices and appearances but also in communication.

We have been taking lessons on a “life without blemish” The scripture says **“Be ye holy in all manner of communication”**; this means that in all we do, we must be holy. When we take it literally, in our communication with our contemporaries, elders, colleagues, we just must be holy.

While we concentrate on the subject of speech, we should know that God looks at all manners of communication: writing, hand gestures, and every other means of communication. It is also important that we know that it is one thing to say the right thing and another thing to say right thing rightly. We must be careful of this; don't say the right thing wrongly.

Some people might not have received answers to their prayers since the camp started because of their tongues; today, God wants to give you solution. It is important we know that we are all in this together. It is a lifelong learning to be able to say the right thing always.

This teaching is divided into four parts; **Source of speech, Medium of speech, Type of speech expected of a child of God and what is not expected, and Practical life applications of how to communicate effectively.**

Source of speech: - Jesus went straight to the source of speech in the first place he said that the mouth speaks out of the abundance of the heart. We have heard sound teachings on how we can have a new heart.

A new heart will bring forth good speech. If we don't have our hearts cleansed, no matter how many communication courses we attend, we can't have good communication. As a little child, I used to slap myself whenever I said something wrong. I shouldn't have slapped myself, because what is pushing me to say that wrong thing is in the inside of me.

Glory to God that Jesus, the communication officer is here. He is the source and His blood is available to cleanse and fumigate all hearts. Jesus in the 35th verse of Matthew 12 said that a good man brings good things and vice versa.

Thank God that we can have our hearts cleansed; if we have yet to do that, God will do it. A clean heart will produce good speech and encouraging words in like manner.

Jesus gave a warning that useless and unnecessary words are idle words and that we should stay away from them. If you will forget everything said here, please remember that all our conversations will stand and face us on the judgment day to condemn if not right.

Medium of speech: - **“If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.” (James 1:26)**

I have a mobile phone. It is a devised meant for communication anywhere.

In the U.K., there are many providers that allow you to choose your preferable subscription. There are unlimited data and unlimited credit. When I used to have limited amount of minute to spend, I controlled myself because I knew what I had. But when you have unlimited credit, like in the UK, there's a service provider called Talk-Talk, so you can keep talking without control. Thinking about it, it occurred to me that speech is an unlimited gift from God to man, but, it comes with the responsibility of controlling yourself. **“In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips is wise.” (Proverbs 10:19)**

When I talk with some people, they'd say that they don't have credit, cannot talk and need to go. In the spiritual context, we should be able to say “I cannot say more than this, my credit is finished.”

We should be able to stop talking and recharge. I believe that is what we have in James 1:26 should teach us how to refrain our lips.

We don't want to practice vain religion because it will bring vain result. I don't want to believe that when we should be exchanging pleasantries, we use our tongues wrongly.

When I finished my research in the U.K., I first worked with the Metropolitan Police and we worked on a data. Also, there is a right of silence in the court. I might not say much about it but I can tell you that most lies are often told in silence. The admonition here is to control and refrain, and not to just keep silent. The heart talks all the time and God takes notes of all.

“My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.” (James 3:1), I don't know if you have come across people that talk about everything and anything: the air, the weather, insects, people, cars, and animals, just anything that they see; they just can't keep silent. It's a big deal for some people and they tell you that is their nature, it can't be helped.

In London, immediately you get to the train station, there's the coined word "see it, say it, sort it" which is only applicable when there's a problem. But for a true child of God, within the context of what we are looking at, it is not everything you see that you say.

Speech is not about speaking, but also your ability to remain silent. May God teach us to say the right thing at the right time.

“Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!”(James 3:5)

Our tongue is a little member that can do great things; it can bring blessings and can also bring great curse.

I have been in a big ship before; it can be high as a three storey building and as huge as the tabernacle. In spite of its size and having many passengers, it is controlled by a small wheel. Same with the tongue; it is small but can put us in trouble if not controlled. It is compared to a raging fire that can affects the whole body, our likes and dislikes and what people say to us does not matter. We should not play with the tongue.

Just a little thing can cause trouble. Some people don't process anything in their mind before saying it. Satan can separate very good friends because of the tongue. A long-time relationship could just suddenly end due to careless talk from one of the friends.

The tongue is likened to a wild beast that cannot be tamed. Praise God that help is available now; our tongue can be tamed by God.

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.” (Proverbs 18:21). What is on your tongue; death or life? Remember, the fruit will come. Do you want to enjoy life and be healthy?

“For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile.” (1 Peter 3:10). May the blood of Jesus wash our tongues.

Types of Speech Expected of a Child of God: - The easiest way to see if one is saved is by listening to them.

“Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.” (James 3:9, 13)

We have many important Bible passages on how we can make use of our tongue and how we should be very careful while using it. **“And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long.” (Psalm 35:28)**

We should use our tongue to say Amen. It surprises me that some people while we are singing just hold their books even when they can sing. We must use our tongues to praise and glorify God.

We use our tongue to speak the word of wisdom. **“The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, and his tongue talketh of judgment.” (Psalm 37:30); “The thoughts of the wicked are an abomination to the LORD: but the words of the pure are pleasant words.” (Proverbs 15:26)**

God did something at our UK camp meeting this year as a result of the tongue. We usually hire coaches to take our members to the rented space for the camp meeting in Wales from London and this year, we hired four coaches. Stella and I were in one of these coaches but our driver wasn't pleasant at the beginning because the coach didn't have good facilities (they were faulty) like we requested for and some people were complaining, asking why we paid for it. I kept quiet, watching the people talking.

The discussion turned nice along the way to the extent that the driver told us he would come to our Camp Meeting from London and he took his vehicle from Wales to London (5hours) to attend the camp because of the discussion he heard in the coach about the Bible, prophecy and good things.

Although he didn't stay long or testify, the seed is sown and we're praying for its germination. Pleasant words bring pleasant results.

“The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine

ear to hear as the learned.” (Isaiah 50:4); our tongues should give words of encouragement. I told a student of mine who came to the office that she could make First Class. She was surprised but I told her she could. She worked for it and made a first class.

Encouraging words go a long way. A person praying for their Christian experience should not be mocked or questioned about the delay. We should encourage them instead of asking them questions on why they don't have it yet. Let them know you're praying for them and that God would do it.

“A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.” (Proverbs 15:1);
“Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.” (Colossians 4:6)

Is your speech seasoned? Is my speech seasoned?

My wife cooks well and I know she spends more time to get it right just so it has a pleasant taste. Have you eaten something bland; no taste? Who wants to eat such? If you eat something tasty, the taste takes time to leave.

So also are good words, soft answers and kind words. People always love hearing them and seeing the people who offer them consistently but when they hurt others, people want to hide when they're coming.

Those with clean hearts will not say derogatory things, they don't backbite, and they will remember Aaron and Miriam what they did to Moses that brought the judgment of God upon them.

Some people are news carriers. I usually tell people not to be the BBC World Service Newscasters. Even when it's true, when did you become a messenger for carrying news? You should not just be spreading news about different places. How did the news spread?

Practical life applications of how to communicate effectively: - Remember the 10 spies that came with discouraging news. When people are gossiping, don't join them, they will be watching and might want to ask you why, you can tell them then that you are a child of God, careful about the things you say because God is watching.

Young people will understand not to use the "F" word. Don't use it because others are using it. We don't use our tongue to call the name of God in vain. Some people are used to anything, even what ridicules God and I dare not even say it the way they say it.

There is nothing wrong in using the name of God when praying. There is nothing wrong in saying God have mercy on me when we see something going wrong. It is however wrong to use it in explaining. A child of God should not get into unnecessary arguments.

“Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: and he that shutteth his lips is esteemed a man of understanding.” (Proverbs 17:28); “Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.” (Proverb21:23)

To be free from trouble, keep your mouth shut. Think before you speak: are my words, kind? Are they necessary? Do not look at other people's faults and discuss them, talk about yourself. If you know that what you want to say will bring problems, keep quiet.

“Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.” (Psalm 141:3)

When you are not sure of what to say or answer, walk away or don't say anything. I have had instances when someone before me will be talking and I will quickly pray, asking God what to say. After a long talk, I might just say, "we shall pray about it." I had training as a pastor and was told that there are certain things that I shall hear, which shall die with me. This was in our Portland Church in my ministerial training as a pastor.

You should not share the unpleasant things that are shared with you. Today, some people are not in one accord because of what they heard someone say about them.

Avoid people that will always have something negative to say about the church leaders. One Overseer (Carver) said we might not hear what you say about the church but one day, it might come in the open, hunting you.

God wants us to mind our conversation. If the spirit of God is telling you that it is your words that are affecting you, I want to assure you that the blood of Jesus is available to cleanse you today.

Topic: HOLY WORSHIP

“After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest.

And he said to me, these are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.”(Revelation 7:9-14)

This is ultimate worship; it is the ultimate and holy worship. Ultimate worship is the ultimate purpose of God for man. We have a final destination not only in terms of location, but in terms of purpose.

What we are going to look out for is the purpose of your life which is beyond this world. Many times we say we want to go to heaven, it is true, but heaven is the purpose.

God has a purpose because his kingdom is vast and he appoints people to fill the place, even in heaven, God has a place for us.

I want you to note some things in what we have read in the book of Revelation which says **“They are clothed in white robes with palms on their hands.”** White robes means holiness, while palms means victory. One day, we are going to be victorious.

Also in verse 14 of the Revelation chapter 7, it says **“These are they that came out from great tribulations and have washed their robes.”** The verse did not say out of great prosperity,

rather it says great tribulations and has washed their clothes in the blood of the lamb. Let us dwell on what the bible says so that we don't make a mistake of our life.

We want to establish that God is a master planner. The topic of the teaching today is "Holiness in Worship" or otherwise "Holy Worship". It will be divided into four parts.

First we want to say something about some sacred facts, then factors that affect holy worship that makes it unholy worship and we also want to consider consequences of unholy worships and finally the blessings of holy worship.

The sacred facts concerning holy worship; first, holy worship here on earth leads to a life without blemish which itself leads to heaven. It is an equation which means holiness on earth, a life without blemish equals to holy worship in heaven.

Worshipping anyhow is what is common all over the world now because the devil targets the Christianity because he know that it is the true religion, looking at other place of worship, the devil does not care, only the worshippers there do guide their place of worships jealously so much that anything contrary will lead to death.

For people worshipping idols, you dare not go to their shrine and do anything you like, the rules must be followed, but in Christianity, the devil has found in roads, so he added many kinds of things that are contrary so that people are now so bold enough to be worshipping the devil himself and God is in heaven looking, however, one day, God will stand up and when that time comes, I pray he will not find you in wrong place.

God is interested in holy worship because that is what they are doing in heaven. In the time of the Israelites, they were taken to the Mount Sinai for almost a year where God is telling them how to worship him, the procedures about how the high priests will offer sacrifices and if he makes any mistake, he is a goner and that is in the wilderness, a bushy place. God's eye is so much on holy worship because he wants a perfect worship.

We can remember the story of Nadir and Abu, children of the high priest; they are the most senior children of Aaron. God has said that fire should be taken from a designated place but they did contrary which resulted into sudden death and God even warned their father not to morn them. We can imagine a father of four that lost his two sons and God commanded him to continue with his work and not morn, that is how serious it is.

The second point we want to consider is that this world we are in is a place of preparation towards heaven.

"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light." (1 Peter 2:9). Note the adjectives that God used, a peculiar people; the fact is that it is not by accident that God called you here, not by saying that you love God, but that God put his love in your heart.

A sister gave a testimony that she was fond of going elsewhere to worship, but one day, in a vision, God told her to leave a lane where she was to another lane and immediately she got to the lane, she saw the person that told her to leave on the screen, so your being here today is planned by God, you have no contribution to it and he also plan to take you to heaven, may you not fail him.

God has made this world a pattern but the real worship and the temple is in heaven and we fail, we will not get to that heaven.

That is the reason God told Moses to be careful of the pattern he gave him, when Jesus was on earth, he taught his disciples the Lord's prayer which part of it reads "As it is done in heaven so on earth." May God help us to understand? Our God is great and he is a master planner.

Science tells us that the outside the planet earth is a vast space which includes the solar system. We have eight planets rotating round the earth and it also says that the Sun is about 1,700 million Km away from the earth and the fastest jet can only reach the sun in 19 years, that is how great our God is.

This is the place where we practise true worship and God's purpose for us in this world for us in his service and to worship him in the acceptable way. When a machine is invented or produced there will be a user's manual and God has gone to a great extent to give us his user's manual which is the Bible.

This day's people have left Gods user's manual and have brought in their own experience. Human beings always think that they are wise, but the wisest person in the world is stupid before God. We must worship God according to his manual.

In the tabernacle worship, if you are not supposed to make a sound and you make it, it may lead to death.

WHAT ARE THE THINGS THAT AFFECT HOLY WORSHIP?

This topic was discussed extensively on Sunday in our lesson and they are three: the person, the place and the process. For worship to be holy, the three must be holy because they are intertwined.

"For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee." (Isaiah 54:7). That is the first requirement, for us to be clean and we cannot be clean on our own nor living a sanctimonious life. The Bible tells us that all our righteousness is like filthy rags, it did not say just a rag, but a filthy one. For us to be clean, we must be saved sanctified and baptised with the holy spirit, and then continue to live a life that will continually reflect the holiness of God and the only way to do that is to be washed in the blood of Jesus.

The blood of Jesus can be likened to the wiper on our wind shield which will wipe away all our uncleanness.

We cannot do the service of God except we are clean and that is the reason workers in this church has a special time within an hour or more to pray. It is not for formality sake, the prayer for the morning service will not suffice for the evening service there is a separate time for each service for prayers. It is only God that can help us to measure up to the standard. A minister or worker cannot just walk from his home to the altar without praying first anything against that is a grave danger.

Place of worship.

The place where we worship God is important; the first place is our heart because it is a worship centre. But we also want to talk about the physical place of worship.

God's house must be beautiful. The tabernacle in the wilderness is very expensive and only God knows how many millions was sunk into its construction, in it, there were gold, silver and other expensive woods, and I wonder if a single person on this earth now can afford to put up such a magnificent structure.

This is because God loves beauty and holiness, no matter where our church is either in the city or in the villages, they must be beautiful and better than our houses but we must be careful of excessive adornment so that the church will not look like a shrine. If we want to see how a beautiful church looks like, you may visit our headquarter church in Anthony village Lagos or the International headquarters in Portland Oregon, U.S.

God has given me the opportunity to visit some of the churches in the U.K.; they are beautiful; we always ensure that the finishing of our buildings is always beautiful and clean.

In (1 Chronicles 29), we see where the king instructed the Levites to clean up the house of the Lord. The house of God must be clean, may God bless our ushers that makes sure that our place of worship is sparkling clean, they are the first class of workers that makes sure that our church is well taken care of, anywhere we find our church our pews are always well dusted and you don't need an handkerchief to clean it up.

The church must be clean inside and outside and it is our duty to set out daily teams that will ensure that the compound of our church is clean, our women do come to church to clean and mop the floor on Saturdays and I pray that the blessings of God will forever follow their children.

The late monarch in one of our branches set out his chiefs to search if they will find pieces of papers littered on the floor of our church in Omu Aran, but they were unable to find any after a monetary reward promised them and that is a small church away from the capital city in Kwara state, Nigeria.

The brethren there kept the traditions of the church. Our prayer room must be structured clean and orderly that is the church God has given to us.

Our pulpit may not be a shining glassy type, but yet, it is beautiful. All the equipment for service and pews are dedicated for Gods service and they cannot be used anyhow.

We use the instrument on the platform for Gods service, they are dedicated to God and we cannot afford to use it anyhow, we must be led by the spirit of God.

The priest Eli warned his children about the desecration of God's service he told them that they can afford to offend man but not God.

THE PROCEDURE

The first thing is the approach to God. We must approach God with humility **“For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.” (Isaiah 57:15)**

God lives on high and lofty place, but then lives in the heart of the humble. When we come before God, we must kneel in reverence and humility in subjection to someone greater than us in supplication.

When we are in church, we cannot talk to God anyhow, we cannot be barking at God, we have to talk to him in humility, not like the Pharisee claiming his work before God but we must be like Jacob who wants mercy from God.

We should also be conscious of our dressings and not appear before God like jezebel with our worldly adornment.

We should not have separate dressings for church and our place of work. A sister once said that she was fond of wearing excessive adornment to church, but one day, God asked her, on the entrance to the church who she was showing off to. We cannot do what we like in the house of God or come with pride in our hearts.

ORDERLINESS AND DECORUM.

“Let all things be done decently and in order.” (1 Corinthians 14:40) For choir members, their entry to church must not be rowdy they must not be talking carelessly. I once ask some people that if they see God physically sitting in the place of the pastor what will be their reaction, some of them said that they will run away, but I said that God is on that platform? Though they cannot see him physically. Careless talking in the house of God is not allowed once we get to the entrance talking must stop.

The church is also not the place to do business, we cannot be discussing personal things inside the church whether the church is in session or not.

We should not also be presumptuous because there is orderliness in heaven. King Uzaiah did contrary and he was stricken with leprosy, we must approach God with fear and implicit obedience.

“Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.” (Psalm 33:8). When you are before God, you should not be moving around disturbing others, we cannot bark at God but we can pray loud like the blind Bartimaeus. We must not turn the church to a house of Baal.

We are warned not to push our unsaved children to the service of God it is dangerous.

CONSEQUENCES OF UNACCEPTABLE WORSHIP

Some people run from one altar to another from one mountain to another if your prayers cannot be answered on this mountain here, then let that request off. There are some things that you cannot have but be assured that God answers prayer only that his response can either be Yes or No! At times it can be wait and then Yes or wait, then No.

You know why God won't give you some things it is because you have prayed that you want to go to heaven, God will surely answer that prayer, but when you ask for something that God knows that will not take you to heaven, he will not answer that prayer.

We read that the saints of God went through tribulations, so we should not make our own Christianity different from their own.

When God has yet to do what you prayed for and you go elsewhere to ask, it is like reporting your own father to another father that your father refuses your request, do you think your father will be happy with you? Wherever you have gone to, because the devil has some powers he will give you what you want but he will add problem to it.

Please don't go about searching and reading prayer books. Prayers are not in books, they are in the heart; if you need any prayer book, consult your Bible and open to the book of Psalms. The bible tells us that the spirit of God prays with us with groaning that cannot be uttered.

People who practise holy worship don't drink anointing oil or drink anointing water, it is not biblical, and it is fake. If you are sick and God wants to take you home, then it is the will of God to take you to worship him in heaven. We cannot have all the pleasures of this earth, the Apostles did not have everything, what they have is beatings and scourge, but we desire to go to the same heaven like them?

Some churches no longer practise holy worship because of unforgiveness. **“But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.” (James 3:17).** If our worship must be accepted by God, we must be united.

When the principal figures of the church are quarrelling and striving, how can they expect God to be there in their midst? And what are they quarrelling for? Positions some desire to be the pastor which is not an easy task.

WHAT ABOUT MURMURING?

May God help us to eradicate murmurings. Some people God gave them light burden, but they are not content, the work of God is not easy. All these people of that are here, do you think it is easy for them? Do you want to be there? You will see what they see. Sometimes their live is wrung, the last water is wrung out for them to be able to seat there. “This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.” (2 Timothy 3:1)


There are people who may doubt if He's coming again. If the prophecies about His first coming were fulfilled, He will come again.

Lovers of pleasure, more than lovers of God. By the grace of God, you will not go back home to become a lover of pleasure.

Worldliness, social media, ungodly entertainment, 419, cultism. The devil is the sponsor of all these. He is looking for people to work for him so that his kingdom can expand. He is struggling to use means available to us and he makes you feel it doesn't matter, that everyone is doing it. Thank God for the gospel, you will not be found wanting.

“Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves.” (Romans 1:21-24). That is the picture of the

world today. They have heard about God but will not receive it. God said their hearts will be darkened.

God is bringing this warning, so you don't become a part of this.

Moral standards have decayed. Moral degradation has become the order of the day and many people have joined **them; will you join them?**

There are so many other dangers. "I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom." (1Timothy 4:1)

My brethren, departing from the faith is one principal sign of the end time. The Bible says the Holy Spirit is speaking expressly that in the last days, some shall depart from the faith. May you not be the one.

Why are they doing that? They are not able to endure sound doctrines of sound teaching. What will follow next? They will speak lies in hypocrisy and will keep doing that. When they don't read their Bible, maybe their neighbours or friends will come to lure you, telling you that we are all the same. Backsliding is not a one day affair; a little moving from studying and believing the word of God will start arguing about the scriptures. May God help us.

Thank God for the gospel, thank God for the Apostolic Faith church, thank God that we have sound doctrine. The word of God is powerful and can pierce like two edged sword.

If you open your heart, this word will quicken you and you will not be a part of those falling in the last days.

Proliferation of false Christ and false prophets; **"And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many." (Matthew 24:3-5, 11).**

There are many false prophets; If you have not seen them, I have. Paul told the Galatians "that he marvelled how soon they were removed from the standard to another gospel which was not truly another gospel but such that arose from among them. Some of them will tell you that they found a new light.

Danger is near. When you leave the fresh meal served here and you're looking for fasting prophets To Help you (you know they exist), may God deliver you.

"For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect." (Matthew 24:24)

People that are in search of signs and wonders, the Bible say the devil has transformed himself as an angel of light. If it is not according to the word of God, it might come to pass but it is not true.

They might tell you that they can have prayer in their house. Someone might tell you that the brother prayed for him and God answered. False prophets will deceive you, exploit you and take advantage of you.

“But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.” (2 Peter 2:1)

It is saddening that many will follow them. May you not be the one.

Do you know why people fall to such things? When they move from the old landmark and start considering the instructions they have received, the spirit of carelessness which can destroy, comes in.

May God help us to hold on to the sound doctrine and continue to lean on God and dip ourselves in the blood on daily basis. They search for the wobbling ones and go for them. May it not be you.

“Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.” (2 Timothy 3:5); the scripture says that they will have the form of godliness but deny the power thereof.

Some people are full of show. They are always busy but lack the power. They have no time for the scriptures. They will be like the five virgins who were busy but empty by the time the master came.

Let us watch and pray and not be careless.

“Abstain from all appearance of evil.” (1 Thessalonians 5:22). Do not keep company of people not committed to the gospel. If you live a life of holiness, they will not look for you to gossip or tell you of a prophet they know. Keep the faith without compromise.

How can we escape or avoid the pitfalls of the last days?

“But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.” (1 Timothy 6:11)

That place says to flee from false prophets, worldliness. You can do this by being prayerful. Prayer works. In this camp, we have learnt pray without ceasing. Study the scriptures and this will help save you. Don't be a careless Christian.

People of God, we have testimonies that we are saved but we have to consecrate our lives daily. The consecration of yesterday will not carry you all week.

Children and young people, this is the day of technology, as this word of God is going on, someone here is chatting. Technology is good but there is an eye that is watching. Technology has brought one of the greatest dangers of this age.

I once asked someone around me and she told me distraction and stuff children should not know. Some of us parents are responsible for this. Young people, be careful the sites you visit. God knows they have the time to read His word instead of being distracted and this will stand against them in judgment.

The food you eat determines your stature. Young people, be warned. The word of God says to put on the whole armour of God. God will keep you if you keep to what you have heard.

TOPIC: JESUS, THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

“In the beginning God created the Heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.” (Genesis 1:1-3)

It is not likely that there are some lives that are in the pre-creation state- formless, void and full of darkness.

Nevertheless, Jesus is ever the same. He needs not make extra effort to transform such lives than He did at the creation. We can deduce from John 1:4 that light is pleasant than darkness. Jesus was born into this world; the world was full of utter spiritual darkness, so much that those who ought to see the light in Jesus Christ could not comprehend it. Light is superior to darkness because it always dispels darkness. May the light of Jesus dispel every darkness in our lives.

“This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin” (1 John 1:5-7).

This text shows how God has classified light and darkness. Originally, God’s creatures are very good but the devil came and inhabited darkness and caused people to indulge in spiritually unwholesome acts. God’s purpose for darkness was to make it a period of rest of all. The devil tries to truncate God’s plan for His creatures- including human and darkness. Hence, God has classified everything sinful, evil, and unrighteous and now He has no part in darkness. Anything unwholesome, unrighteous, unholy is the devil’s and the devil inhabits darkness.

Light is where one wants people to see all that one does. Light is where everything is placed face-up on the table. Anyone still engaging in evil and sinful things is pitching his tent with the devil, he is in darkness. The light of Jesus will take those in darkness from the kingdom of

darkness to the kingdom of light. **“And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest, And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem. And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven.” (Acts 9:1-3)**, it states the account of a man who was in spiritual darkness. He was walking in darkness and doing all he could to put out the light of Jesus. He wanted to prevent the light of the gospel from shining. These he was doing in ignorance. However, Jesus shed His light on the path of this man. May God shed His light on the path of all in darkness.

Those in darkness, troubling Christianity and warring against the children of God are doing so out of ignorance. We need to pray for them because all they need is the light of God.

The light of God can shine on all militating against the spread of the Gospel. The devil cannot put out the light of God. If you allow the light of God in you, then you are unmovable. Are you afraid of what would happen tomorrow? The Gospel of God will undertake. **“Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.” (Acts 9:31)**, God will give us rest all around. The light being discussed is not of the sun or moon. **“Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.” (John 8: 12)**, the light is from Heaven, Jesus is no ordinary light. Jesus describes the light as The Life. This implies that those in darkness are dying. The light of Heaven in anyone will sustain him.

“Jesus went unto the mount of Olives.” (John 8:1). Let us consider the event that preceded Jesus’ declaration of himself as the light of the world. This incident proves the efficacy of the light. The woman was in utter darkness; she was condemned to death, hopeless and isolated. She was worse than dead. They were planning to kill her but; they brought her to the Great advocate who can turn darkness to light. Nobody can hide from Jesus because Jesus is the light. The woman was condemned, hopeless and was waiting for Judgment.

Maybe that is your state too. Jesus can light up your life. Probably you have been sentenced; Jesus can remove the condemnation and justify you. He can turn your darkness into light. However, you must first confess your sins.

It is customary that when other men know your secret, they will molest you just like the accusers of this woman. Are you being ridiculed or judged by men? God wants to turn your sorrow to joy. It is glorious for Jesus to say, “Go and sin no more”. Turn to Jesus and He will turn

your darkness to light, justify you and preventing the devil from condemning you to death. Jesus the light of the world is waiting to shed His light in your life.

I want to assure you that if you have faith, except your future is destroyed, Obi will become a man. You will smile because everything about you will change.

We live by faith. Going to Heaven doesn't mean you should remain in suffering. Your situation will change after the camp meeting. God wants you to know that when you give Him your time and do all He wants you to do. Something wonderful will happen to you tonight.
