### Congo

26th Annual Convention of the Apostolic Faith, Congo, titled, 'The Benefits and Glory of Godliness' came up between Sunday, 2 December, 2012 and 16 December, 2012. Delegates came from many Congo provinces including Maniema where delegates have not attended since 1989 due to political unrest. A woman participated in the Convention after travelling more than 4,300km in 15 days.

The Convention was preceded by the Conference of Ministers and Gospel Workers on 29 and 30 November, 2012 led by Rev. G. K. Ajayi, Regional Overseer, Lagos Region, Nigeria. The attendance this year was lower than recent attendances because of the weather. Other WECA representatives at the Convention were: Rev. Rachel Fakorede and Brother Yves Ahomian

Over 163 people were blessed with salvation, sanctification, baptism of Holy Ghost, healing, re-anointing and other blessings. A total of 688 candidates participated in this year's ordinance of Water Baptism. ## Port Harcourt

Port Harcourt Region also had their annual camp meeting from December 9 to 23 in the city of Port Harcourt.

A pre – camp meeting revival meetings held in 7 zones of the Rivers District from November 12 to 22, 2012. Services were held in 42 locations across the state during which time printed leaflets and posters announcing date for the camp meeting were circulated.
