## Foreign Mission

### Togo

On June 15, 2012, delegates from WECA headquarters paid a visit to Togo. They remained there till Monday, June 18. The mission of the visit was to encourage the brethren in Togo and bring good wishes from WECA headquarters to them especially as their leader was just recovering from injuries sustained from an accident. Another objective was to map out strategies by which the existing administrative structure would be made more functional and effective. Finally,

revival services were to be conducted.

The forward team: Brother Kayode Oje, Director, (Missions) and Sister Rachel Fakorede, Deputy Director, (Foreign Missions). They were joined by Brothers Valentine Akanro (Assisting Overseer in Benin Republic), Samuel Gbede (Cotonou) Noah Chetan (Cotonou) and Lawrence Fosudo who drove the team.

The mission team visited the Country leaders' home and expressed the warm wishes of good health from the District Superintendent.

Worship activities have tremendously improved due to the constant visitation from Benin Republic.

The team was happy with some aspects of worship especially music. Music awareness was very high and singers are talented and performed well.

God visited brethren in a tremendous way during this period as 7 souls were saved, 2 sanctified, 2 healed, resulting to 22 blessings God showered on them.

The main objective of the visit was to conduct training on Mission and Worship Administration for pastors and senior ministers.

The District Superintendent

presented a seminar on: The Heart and the Home of a Servant of God as it affects his/her worship and mission environment. The importance of quality control in worship administration was also discussed.

Operation strategies were also discussed with the participants. There was also an interactive session in which issues concerning a convention for the 3 districts were discussed.

At Kwara District, Ote branch church was one the branch churches visited.

This was the branch where God performed a miracle on a boy who was bent and God straightened him upright by the laying of hands of elders. Also, at Kwara, building projects at different levels of completion were inspected.

Devotional, youth and evangelistic services, were held at Ilorin church. The attendance was so encouraging. For the morning service, 1,042 people were present while for the evening service, 850 people were in attendance. The blessings of God was also showered upon his people as 16 souls were saved, 4 sanctified, and 5 healed,
