JESUS WAS BAPTIZED LESSON 16

Matthew 3:1-12; Mark 1:1-11; John 1:19-28 Memory Verse: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17)

There was a man of God called John the Baptist. He was not living in the city where people lived, but in the wilderness. But John was not afraid. He knew God was with him. John was sleeping in a cave. His clothes were made of camel's hair and his food were locusts, a species of grasshopper, and honey kept by the honey-bee in a cave or tree.

John loved to be far away from his people to be able to have the chance to think about God, because he was soon to start preaching to people and to teach them the acceptable way of listening to Jesus when preaching some day. God told John to tell the people that Jesus was coming and that He is the Son of God. He told them it was a bad thing to sin. He told the people to be sorry for their sins, ask God to forgive them and decide not to sin again. Many repented and asked God for the forgiveness of their sin. After this John would baptize them in the river Jordan.
